I am directed to forward herewith the following recommendations of the Executive Committee as approved by the Council, for your information and necessary action :-

"The Executive Committee recommends to the Council that J.L.N. Medical College, Belgaum, be approved for the award of the MBBS degree granted by Karnatak University provided that the number of admissions into that college is restricted to 75 students per annum. The Superintendent of the hospital can hold beds only in his speciality. The attention of the authorities concerned is also invited for implementation of the various other recommendations and suggestions made by the Inspector in the report."
