
Sir,

As informed by you that you have not received any communication regarding the above subject, I give below the decision taken by the Postgraduate Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 31st Oct./1st Nov., 1991 for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Committee recommends that JLN Medical College, Belgaum be approved for the award of MD(Physiology) qualification granted by Karnatak University and attention of the authorities concerned be drawn towards implementation of various recommendations and suggestions made by the Council Inspector in the inspection report. The student: teacher ratio of 1:1 as prescribed by the Council should be strictly adhered to and the students should be admitted only against recognised postgraduate teachers as per Medical Council of India regulations. The Lecturers not possessing required postgraduate qualification should be redesignated as Tutor/Demonstrator. However, no increase of seats to be made without the prior approval of the Council."

I am further to draw your attention to section 10A(1)(b)(i) of the Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Act, 1993 under which no medical college shall increase its admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training) except with the previous permission of the Central Govt. obtained in accordance with the provision of this section.
