

Poisonous animals 1.5 Saw scaled viper :

Scientific name : Echis carinatus

Identification :

- The saw-scaled viper (afai, echis carinate) is brown, half metre in length, and has wavy white line on each flank of the back with diamond-shaped areas between these two lines.
- 2. It has a triangular head, the upper surface of which is covered with a white mark resembling a <u>bird's foot-print or an arrow.</u>
- 3. The tail is short and tapering.
- 4. The broad belly plates with brown or dark spots, small scales on the head, and entire shields beneath the tail are the distinguishing features.

Nature of venom : Predominantly vasculo- and haemotoxic

Antidote : Antisnake venom (ASV)
