

Poisonous animals 2.5 Grass snake

<u>Scientific name :</u> Natrix Natrix

Other common name : Ringed snake

Identification :

- 1. The common grass snake (*N. natrix*), which is the most terrestrial of the water snakes, inhabits all of Europe and western Asia.
- 2. It is olive-coloured, green, or grey, with a yellow or white collar on the neck.
- Adults range in length <u>from 0.6 to 1 metre (2 to 3 feet); however, some may reach 2</u> metres (about 6.5 feet) in length.
- 4. The <u>recurved small teeth of the grass snake form two rows in the upper jaw and one</u> row on the dentary.

<u>Nature of venom</u> : Its venom mainly contains **neurotoxins** which have paralyzing activities to the nervous system and <u>cardiotoxins which act cytolytically</u>.
