

Poisonous animals 4.6 Dio don

<u>Scientific name</u> : dio don

<u>Common name</u>: porcupine fish, balloon fish

Identification:

- 1. <u>Body is rounded, globose</u> and covered with numerous flexible spines, the organs of defence; they are erected to protect from enemy.
- 2. Some forms inflate their bodies by swallowing water.
- 3. Scales generally spiny or bony.
- 4. Body divided into head, trunk and tail. Head contains mouth, nostril and large rounded eyes.
- 5. Inter-operculum is rod like and attached to the anterior limb of suboperculum. Paired pectoral fin near operculum.
- 6. This fish has flexible spines and globose body and above features, hence it is Diodon

Nature of venom: tetrodotoxin (TTX), it is a neurotoxin
