B25 – STONES IN FOOT

<u>HISTORY:-</u> Twenty years old male had multiple discharging sinuses, above the level of left ankle joint. The discharge contained bones spicules. He was diagnosed as a case of chronic osteomyelitis and was operated by an orthopedic surgeon. At the time of operation the surgeon noticed multiple stones at the operation site.

GROSS:- Amputated specimen of left foot. The little toe is missing. Above the level of lateral malleolus a depigmented patch measuring 4x3 cms. is seen. A deep cut is seen at the level of lateral malleolus. A stone measuring about 0.8 cms is visible through this cut.

C/s shows a pear shaped cavity above the level of calcaneus, through which a stone is visible.

Imp:- Stones in the foot.

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
