


## B29 – MILIARY T.B. LIVER



HISTORY:- A female patient aged about 52 years came <sup>with h/o</sup> history of fever, loss of appetite and cough with expectoration for three months. On examination showed tenderness in right hypochondrium and a cavity in the lung. Signs of meningeal irritation were present. Patient died. Autopsy conducted.

GROSS APPEARANCE:- Specimen of liver, normal in size. Surface is greyish white in colour and show grey nodules of varying size between 1 mm. to 5 mm. in diameter sparsely distributed all over the surface. Cut section shows widely spread grey nodular lesion in the liver parenchyma. Few nodules are quite bigger in size measuring about 2 to 3 Cms. in diameter and show cheesy material in the centre. In one of these nodular lesion central ones show haemorrhage.
