

C.V.S. 1 Normal heart

## Gross:

- 1. Given specimen is of adult human heart normal shape, size, smooth surface, firm without any discoloration or adhesions .
- 2. Normal weight: 300 g. (males); 250 g. (females); It is 0.4 to 0.45% body weight. Length 12.5 cm; Width 9 to 10 cm. (at atrioventricular groove).
- 3. Thickness of auricular and ventricular walls appears to be normal.
- 4. There are no blood clots.
- 5. Coronaries and other large vessels are patent

## <u>MLI :</u>

- 1. Sudden death can occur due to vasovagal attack, Myocardial infarction, Arrythmias, Concussion, air embolism
- 2. Injuries: Rupture to right ventricle can be fatal.
- 3. Poisons: aconite paralysis of heart

Cerebra odollum (can cause heart failure within 3 hrs of consumption)

**Digitalis** ( cardiac failure and arrythmias )

Nerium odorum (petechial hemorrhages)

Viper bite ( stiffness of heart muscle )

**Scorpion bite** (arrythmias and anterior hemiblock)

4. Cardiac abnormalities like ventricular arrythmias are most common cause of death in electrocution
