

C.V.S. 2 Paediatric heart:

## Gross:

- 1. Given specimen is of paediatric heart normal shape, size, smooth surface, firm without any discoloration or adhesions .
- 2. Normal weight -: 50-200 gms depending on age and health of child.
- 3. Heart is in more horizontal position than in adult.
- 4. Right side of heart is fairly large in children.
- 5. Epicardium is thin and fat layers are missing.

## <u>MLI</u> –

- 1. In children cardiac failure is mainly due to as a consequence of congenital heart diseases (CHDs) or cardiomyopathies .
- 2. Chest radiography is indicated in all children with suspected HF to assess heart size and to check for other signs of HF such as pulmonary oedema, septal lines (or Kerley B lines), and pleural effusions.
