

C.V.S. 5 Cardiomegaly:

Gross:

- 1. Given specimen is of human heart which is **enlarged with smooth glistening surface**, firm without any discolorations or adhesions or haemorrhages over its surface.
- 2. Right and left **ventricular wall thickness is more** . (normal thickness of right ventricle is 3-5 mm and that of left ventricle is 15-20 mm) .
- 3. length and width of heart are also more than normal. (the normal heart length and width are 12 cm and 8.5 cm). However there are no blood clots.

MLI:

- 1. Cardiomegaly can be attributed to pre existing conditions like diabetes mellitus, obesity, congenital heart disease.
- 2. It is condition which can be seen in **chronic cocaine drug addicts**, **Amphetamines** and its derivatives and androgenic anabolic steroids are known to cause cardiac hypertrophy.
