

C11 – SARCOID GRANULOMAS- SUBSCAPULAR REGION



HISTORY:-

34 years old man came with lump at the left scapular region and breathlessness - months. Swelling of left upper limb - 1 month. Past history of above knee amputation of left lower limb 3 years back. Patient was diagnosed as case of sarcoidosis - after biopsing - lymph nodes, skin and muscle. He was treated with corticosteroids.

OTHER INVESTIGATIONS CARRIED OUT

- (a) Tuberculin - Negative.
- (b) Granulomas were negative for Acid fast organisms.
- (c) Culture & Animal inoculation for Mycobacterium tuberculosis were negative.
