C16 – SACROCOCCYGEAL TERATOMA



GP C-16

<u>HISTORY:-</u> New born female child presented with swelling over sacrococcygeal region. Clinically diagnosed as sacrococcygeal teratoma.

GROSS:- Excised mass from sacrococcygeal region. Measures 5x4x2 cms. External surface is covered with skin. Shows two distinct lobes. The upper lobe is smaller and the skin shows wrinkling. Appears pink in colour. The skin covering the lower lobe is smooth.

C/s of the mass shows greyish areas. They are intervened by dark coloured areas. They appear in the form of streaks indistinctly seperating the greyish areas. The upper pole of the mass shows two small cystic spaces.

MICROSCOPY:- Sections studied from the mass show a benign growth. Shows nerve tissue, nerve bundles. Blood vessels are prominent.

IMPRESSION:- Teratoma - Sacrococcygeal region.

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
