C5 – MALIGNANT ULCER

MALIGNANT ULCER

A female patient of 60 years old with the history of 1) Ulcer at the axilla and (2) Suspected carcinoma of breast.

GROSS APPEARANCE:- Specimen consists of a breast tissue along with large area of skin about 17 cms x 6 cms. Nipple and areola are present and they are normal. There is a huge enacuvating ulcer about 6 1/2 cms from the nipple, measuring 6x5 cms with 3 cms depth. The margins are irregular and everted. Floor of the ulcer is shaggy and necrotic.

Surrounding surface is irregular. Cut surface shows nodular homogeneous growth with area of haemorrhage.

DIAGNOSIS:- Malignant ulcer.

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
