

1. **Excretory: 6. Multilobulated kidney**

- A specimen shows both kidney with multiple lobes of kidney with
- Both kidneys with ureters from the medial aspect.
- Lobules on the surface mimics like renal scars

**Dimension**

- 10x4x2.5 cm

**General description**

- The metanephric kidney in foetal life is developed in the form of lobules, with the growth of nephrons these lobules fuse in adult kidney but in some conditions the lobular patterns persist leading to lobulated kidney in adults.
- These lobulations mimic as renal infarcts or renal scars in CT &MRI.
