

## GIT 10 HEMORRHAGE IN GASTRIC MUCOSA GROSS

specimen shows hemorrhages, multiple dark stripes on gastric mucosa

Hemorrhage in gastric mucosa present in head injury case

The surface of the mucous membrane is covered by a single layer of columnar epithelium.

## **SALIENT FEATURES:**

Hemorrhage in gastric mucosa present in head injury case.

- ABRUS PRECATORIUS
- Ingestion of seeds or extract can cause haemorrhagic gastritis.
- **Fatal Dose**: 90 to 120 mg. (one to 2 seeds) by injection. Subcutaneously abrin is 100 times as toxic as by the oral route.
- Fatal Period: Three to five days.

## **CERBERA ODALLAM**

- Stomach mucosa is congested with **submucous haemorrhages and gastritis**.
- The internal organs are Congested
- Fatal Dose : Kernel of one fruit.
- Fatal Period : One to two days or more
