

GIT 8 CURLING ULCERS

GROSS

• Curling's ulcers are sharply punched-out mucosal defects

SALIENT FEATURES:

- Stress ulcers (Curling ulcers) are produced in the duodenum commonly in the **first** part, in less than 10% cases, about the tenth day in extensive bums of the body.
- It develops due to **mucosal ischemia** as a result of stress and shock, and not related to acidity.
- **Petechiae** of stomach and duodenum, often with erosions, occasionally acute ulcers, is a more common finding.
- The gastric ulcers may occur within a day of burning.
- There may be **bacterial or fungal colonies** in the floors of the ulcers.
- Erosion of large vessels occasionally produce fatal haemorrhage.
