

HEP B 5 LACERATED LIVER

GROSS

• Tears are often **irregular in nature**, but have been shown to be almost parallel in many cases.

SALIENT FEATURES:

- The liver is more susceptible than spleen to penetrating injury.
- It is the **second most** frequently damaged abdominal organ in blunt trauma.
- The liver is commonly ruptured by motor accidents, blow, kick
- The **right lobe** is five times more commonly affected than the left.
- Convex surface and inferior border are commonly involved.
- Liver ruptures are more frequent in falls from height than in other mechanism of blunt abdominal trauma
