General description

- Organ of lymphatic system situated in left hypochondrium between 9th to 11th ribs
- It is a primary filtering element for the blood
- It also stores and release certain immune cells that mediate inflammation
- Encased into a thick connective capsule
- It contains intermingling white pulp and red pulp

- 2. Subcapsular rupture
- 3. Evaluate the intensity of the blunt abdominal trauma
